

No Jesus No Grace .Com

Allow me to explain the meaning of No Jesus No Grace.

Without Jesus there is no grace. Jesus put it like this: “ I am the way and the truth and the life: No man comes to the Father but by me. If you had known me, you should have known my Father also: and from now on, you know Him and have seen Him.” (John 14:6&7)

Paul put it like this: “Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.” (Acts 4:16)

You see, the irrefutable truth, is that every human being sins and falls short of the glory of God. (Romans 3:23)

And the penalty for any sin in thought or in deed is eternal separation from God. “For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God, is eternal life through Jesus Christ.” (Romans 6:23)

That is why no other religion gives the promise of eternal life. In every other religion, one must earn their way to heaven, which is utterly impossible: “When His disciples heard it, they were exceedingly amazed, saying, who then can be saved? Jesus answered and said to them, “With men, this is impossible; but with God, nothing is impossible.” (Matthew 19:25&26)

Here is the great new of God’s love and grace: “But God proved His love for us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Jesus died for us”. (Romans 5:8)

Jesus paid for our sins (past, present and future) once for all on the cross. Praise Jesus!!!!!! “By which will (the will of God) we are sanctified (found not guilty and in right standing) through the offering of the body of Jesus, ONCE FOR ALL!!!!!! But this man (Jesus), after he had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down on the right hand of God.” (Hebrews 10:10&12)

It is by love and grace (God’s willingness ability and power; that has done those things for us, that we can not or will not do for ourselves) that we have been saved. All we must do to walk in and receive all of the promises of God, is to believe on Him and believe Him:

“For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in Him, should not perish but have ever lasting life.” (John 3:16)

“That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus, and shall believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you shall be saved. For with the heart man believes unto righteousness and with the mouth confession (stating belief) is made unto salvation.” (Romans 10: 9&10)

If you believe in Jesus and make Him the King of your life, you will be saved eternally and walk in His promises. Do you have to do works and be good and/ or keep the: Ten Commandments? Here is what Jesus and Paul say: NO!!!!!!

“Then they said to Him, what shall we do, that we might work the works of God? Jesus answered them saying, this **is the work of God that you believe on Him whom He has sent.**” (John6: 28&29).

When we place ourselves under a works or performance based relationship with God, we reject the grace of God and the blood of Jesus; then we pay a terrible price:

“ For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse (Deuteronomy 28:15-68) for it is written, cursed is every one that continues not in ALL THAT ARE WRITTEN IN THE BOOKS OF THE LAW TO DO THEM.” (Galatians 3:10) What this means is that if you want to keep the commandments you also have to keep all 613 ordinances found in the first four books of the bible. And you can't break any of them ever in thought or deed. And by the way, even if you did keep them you would accomplish nothing because unless you are born Jewish, they never have and never will apply to you because you are a gentile:

“Therefore, remember that at that time (before Jesus) you were Gentiles (heathens) in the flesh, called uncircumcised by those who call themselves circumcised [Itself a mere mark in the flesh] made by human hands. Remember that at that time you were separated (living apart) from Jesus [excluded from all part in Him], utterly estranged from Israel as a nation, and strangers with no share in the sacred compacts of the Messianic promise [with no knowledge of or right in God's agreements, His covenants.] And you had no hope (no promise); you were lost, and were in the world without God. But now in Jesus, you who were so far away, through the blood of Jesus have been brought near.”
(Ephesians 2:11-13)

But if we are so wrongheaded as to try to please God by performance or keep the commandments, this is what happens to us:

“In this freedom, Jesus has made us free [and completely liberated us]; stand fast then, and do not be hampered and held ensnared and submit again to a yoke of slavery [which you have once and for all put off”].

“Notice, it is I, Paul who tells you that if you receive circumcision (place yourself in a performance based relationship with God by trying to be good or keep the commandments) Jesus will be of no profit, advantage or avail to you [for if you distrust Him you can gain nothing from Him.”]

“I once more protest and testify to every man who receives circumcision that he is UNDER OBLIGATION AND BOUND TO PRACTICE THE WHOLE OF THE LAW AND ITS ORDINANCES. (All 613 of them found in the first 4 books of the Bible. Good Luck.)

“If you seek to be justified (found not guilty) and declared righteous and to be given right standing with God through the law, you are brought to nothing and so separated (severed) from Jesus. YOU HAVE FALLEN AWAY FROM GRACE!!!!!!!!”

(Galatians 5:1-4 Amplified Bible)

Here then is our recipe for Joy, Peace, Health, Prosperity and Service to our King:

“For by grace have you been saved through faith, (living in the present moment with a positive imagination of the things not seen but promised by the Word. Now faith is the substance of things hoped for the evidence of things not seen. Hebrews 11:1) and that (faith) is not of yourselves, it is a gift from God, not of works lest any man should boast.”
(Ephesians 2:8&9)

Our relationship with God is based on grace through faith, or works and performance. The choice is ours. There is no middle ground. Either Jesus did it all, or He did nothing and it is up to us.

“For I am not ashamed of the Gospel of Jesus: for it is the power of God to salvation to everyone that believes; first to the Jew and then to the Gentiles. For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith, for it is written, the just shall live by faith.” (Romans 1:16&17)

And we have been given, the full measure of faith. It can't be added to, subtracted from divided or multiplied. It is a free and complete gift from God.

“Simon Peter a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that have (past tense) obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of God and our Savior Jesus.” (Second Peter 1:1)

“ Blessed be to the Father of our Lord Jesus, who hath (past tense) blessed us with ALL spiritual blessings (including faith) in heavenly places in Jesus” (Ephesians 1:3)

What are the Spiritual blessings, which have been given us?

“But the fruit (blessings) of the Spirit are: love, joy, peace, patience, gentleness, goodness and FAITH.” (Galatians 6:22) No gift from God is incomplete.

“Now to him that works is the reward not reckoned of grace, but of debt. But to him that works not but believes on Him that justifies the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness.” (Romans 4:4&5)

“Therefore, since we are justified (acquitted, declared righteous, and given a right standing with God) through faith, let us grasp the fact that we [have the peace of reconciliation to hold and enjoy] peace with God through our Lord Jesus.”

“Through Him also we have our access (entrance introduction) into this grace,(God’s willingness, ability and power that has done for us those things which we can not or will not do for ourselves) in which we firmly and safely stand, And let us rejoice and exult in our hope of experiencing and enjoying the glory of God.”

(Romans 5:1&2 Amplified Bible)

Praise Jesus!!!!!!!!!!!!!! Every breathing Christian; should have Romans 5:1&2 memorized and recite it all day long every day. Especially when the devil tries to convince us that if we sin, God will not bless us. Which as we know, is foolishness since while we were yet sinners, Jesus died for us.
